Ben: Yes, we did. We had a pine.

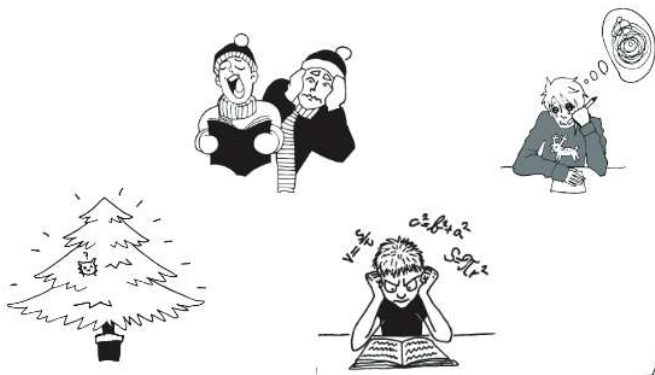
